Feedback from students, parents and staff during the School Self Evaluation process indicated a strong request to look at the way the school recognises student achievement. It is anticipated that award recipients will then be made mention in the fortnightly school newsletter as well.

### **Future Focused Learning - Stage 2 Video Conference**

Last week Stage 2 took a virtual trip to the Australian National Museum via the video conference facilities within the school, to study frogs and how they contribute to ecosystems. They were encouraged to download the Frog ID app and get outdoors to listen to frog calls and then report the species found back to the Australian Museum. The students enjoyed the opportunity to engage in question and answer sessions with a specialist frog scientist. Some questions included; what do frogs eat? What is a frog's life span? Are frogs poisonous? & What are the threats to frogs? As follow up activities, students have been electronically submitting their projects with their research findings. Well done Cooper O-M from 3/4A for his poster and Anabelle H, Anika P & Peta W also from 3/4A for their slide show. Stage 2 looks forward to using the video conference facilities more often.
