#### Principal's Report Quality Work

Term 4's gifted and talented programs for Stage 2 and 3 students involved creating artworks with a focus on sustainability. Students created a design that used images to promote a 'sustainable' action, which was to use eco reusable bags rather than single-use plastic bags.
